We use the Hard style of Okinawan/Japanese straight line fighting and the Soft style of Chinese Kempo and that which is angular or circular movements. Goju Ryu therefore has the best of both fighting traditions of Okinawan and Chinese.

We combine jamming, isolation, and parry combinations into a single fighting form. We also utilize the talents of other arts of self-defense for completeness to adapt to any attack on the streets.
