Friendly Reminder: Attention Parents and Students! Monthly Tuition Increase Jan 2012 Please See New Brochures!

Please note, prior to last year to assist our students and their families during difficult economic times; Tibon's Goju Ryu had not raised it's tuitions for the past three years. Unfortunately we now find we must raise our monthly tuition, because of our rising operating costs.

Effective January 1, 2012, an increase of an additional \$5.00 per month, per student will be assessed. This nominal increase is less than .65 cents per class, and represents only a small portion of the increases we are experiencing.

It is our expressed wish; these new tuition fees will not present a hardship to anyone, and please realize we always try very hard to give the best value in instruction and investment, for all of our students training in traditional karate and Kobudo.

A quick survey of our local competitors, assures us we are offering quality instruction at a more modest rate, for up to twice the amount of real class-time instruction. Further, we feel we have a proven record of being a karate school that strives for excellence in developing our students to reach a national and international level of development. This is confirmed by our ability to place athletes on the U.S. National Karate Team every year.

We hope you understand the necessity to raise tuitions, to compensate for higher costs in doing business and in order to keep our programs at the high level of technical quality that you have come to expect.

Count Down The Year 2011 What a Great Year for Accomplishments!

On **December** 3rd 2011 20 of Tibon's black belts are successful in new Dan certification, all 20 are traveling to Canada to the Stevenson International Karate Championships in Richmond B.C. to make this our large black belt delegation in 15 years. We hope all are successful in their competition divisions. Their ranks will be awarded at a special ceremony presentation during the tournament. In November Jesse Toy and Joane Orbon at Worlds in Malaysia, Sensei Gene Tibon is inducted to the Stockton Sports Hall of Fame, and Yvonne Tibon runs her first half marathon for 13.1 miles and becomes role model for hundreds. October Joane Orbon and Jesse Toy both traveled to Brazil to the 2011 XXII Junior Pan-American Championships in Fortaleza Brazil August 28th – September 4th, 2011. They will be competing with the best of the 35 Pan-American countries athletes, who all represent their nations governed by their national governing body's sanctioned by their Olympic Committees. Joane Orbon's first match was against Brazil which she dominated with a score of 9-2, her second match she lost by a controversial call when she kicked the Mexico female to the head and was penalized and lost against Mexico. Joane's third match for the Bronze medal was against Venezuela where she dominated again 3-0 in scoring points. Jesse Toy's first match was a close match against Mexico that he lost 1-2. Jesse feels he was just a little to careful in his match and should have been a little more aggressive, but will be ready for the World Championships in Malaysia. September 50 families travel with the Central Valley Karate Boosters Families of Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting Arts Organization Six Flags Discovery Kingdom family trip, September students traveled to the Shotokan Nationals in San Francisco and did fantastic in competition and refereeing and judging. August Sensei Tibon hold 4th world class USA Grassroots Karate Camp at the University of the Pacific with over 200 athletes from all over the country and Canada. July two go to USA Team Trials in Houston, Texas to win places on Team USA to Brazil and Malaysia. June We travel to Cupertino to Sensei Mary Crawford Karate Tournament in Saratoga, CA. need Black Belts for Referee, Judge, and compete all Tokubetsu and A-Team should be also participating in this tournament. "Central Karate Boosters setting up Tailgate Party with Parents Potluck." May Members of Tibon's Goju Ryu from the main dojo in Stockton, Stockton GymStars, and Modesto GymStars gather together travel to Fresno to Quan Karate Tournament and dominate the WKF Kumite division, and do outstanding in Kata. We had 24 students from these three Karate programs together won took 44 medals. With 17 gold medals, 19 silver, and 8 bronze medals. We had Brian Embry and Joane Orbon both won the Male adult and Female Adult Grand championships for Kumite and both took the Grand championship money award. We also had successful Tibon's Goju Ryu Summer Camp was huge success. April Three of our athletes from Tibon's Goju Ryu travel this year to the USA Jr. Olympics and to the US Open at Caesar's Palace in Las Vegas, NV on Easter Weekend to compete with 2000 competitors and 50 countries in the competition. Aleesa Ohata won gold medal in Kata at the USA Jr. Olympics, also a bronze in Kumite, and in Weapons. She also won a Bronze Medal in Kata at the US Open and Andrew Moore won a Silver medal in the Men's Black Belt Kata. Central Valley Karate Boosters hold annual Easter Egg Hunt at Swenson's Park. March Sensei Javier Mantilla WKF Referee Workshop teaches world-class training for our athletes in our main dojo to prepare our athletes for Team USA Team Trials this workshop was required for all Leadership. February We had 11 black belts and one orange belt travel by Car, and by air from Stockton to Richmond B.C. Canada Through black ice, snow, and rain. Everybody arrived Safe and made an impressive statement of quality and technique to win many of the medals in the Black Belt Divisions they competed in. January we just finished one of our largest Tibon's Goju Ryu IN HOUSE tournaments and kick off the New Year with a new group of students who participated in their first Karate competition. The comments from parents and students have prompted up to do a Tibon's Goju Ryu Summer IN HOUSE Karate Tournament in June 2012, along with our Winter Tibon's IN HOUSE in December 2012. These two tournaments are some of the best tournaments in Western United States. We will also be inviting different dojos of different styles to compete with our athletes for more exposure to competition.



Hello Sensei,

I just wanted to give a update you on the status of my at-risk youth Martial Arts program. January will be our 1st year anniversary. The program is called V.O.M.A.P which stands for Victory Outreach Martial Arts Program. It's through our church (Victory Outreach Ministries) worldwide. As a matter of fact, our program has been so successful they launched a similar program at our sister church in San Jose. They have plans to launch this type of program to the youth ministries to all of our churches. We have over 700 churches in over 29 states in the US and 25 countries worldwide. This could be huge! There have been so many success stories so far.

One example, I have student names David Domiguez who is 17 years old. Prior to him entering the program he was as at-risk as they come! He was hanging around the wrong crowd (gang bangers and thugs) who wanted to recruit him. He was being brought home every other week by juvenile probation or by the Police. He was on the verge of dropping out of High School. He would get into fights with his parents; he actually swung at his father once. Just 3 months after joining VOMAP, his entire life was changed completely! The entire church, our Pastor and his parents can't tell me enough how good he has become. He is a role model now. I actually use him as an assistant to allow him to hold a leadership role to improve his interpersonal communication skills. He is looking like he will make honor roll this next report card period and now has a goal of attending college to become a law enforcement official. He is my most dedicated student. He has never missed one class since the beginning. I could not be more proud of him! This is just one of a dozen different success stories that my program has created.

Several of my students want to compete at the in house tournament next weekend. I have a few students I think will do very well in their divisions. I have passed out registration forms, I will know by tomorrow who will actually compete for sure. Their katas look pretty strong.

Once again, thank you so much for the opportunity and the guidance you have given me to allow this much needed community service to take place! This is such a blessing to so many lives that are affected by this program. It makes such a huge impact on these disenfranchised members of the community that our church serves.

I have attached some photos and some verbiage that's on our literature we had out at our church. Organization's Mission Statement of Victory Outreach martial Arts Program (V.O.M.A.P.)

To provide martial arts training that encourages personal growth and development for each individual student at his or her own pace, emphasizing both physical and mental conditioning. To uphold standards of

excellence that inspires students to see beyond their current potential and reach new levels of personal success by setting goals and achieving them, building character, and improving confidence and self-esteem. To instill traditional martial arts values of respect, discipline, honor, loyalty, family, and courage, building leadership skills and social accountability. To provide an environment that supports each student on their martial arts journey toward discovering and claiming their own personal power from within and teaching the discipline and self-control to take responsibility for that power.

The study and practice of the ancient traditional Martial Arts systems such as Karate-do by youth has proven to be effective in developing discipline, respect, integrity, courage, leadership, teamwork, self-esteem, confidence and honor. Many youth today lack these essential qualities that may take many years to develop on their own. By providing these at-risk youth a positive training environment and safe effective instruction, we strive to forge a new generation of young leaders who can take with them the values learned on the mat and apply these concepts to lives to prepare for the real world. With these principles guiding their path, our community will be improved and the youth will be diverted from other destructive behavior. Additionally the student will also have improved in all the listed areas below:

Experience and learn positive health skills and concepts.

- Develop decision-making skills through actual experience.
- Become more self-confident, improve self-esteem, and increase a sense of personal security.
- Express and understand creative, cooperative, competitive, and assertive behaviors, which are needed and encouraged within society.
- Learn self-discipline and good sportsmanship.
- Understand the spirit of participating in body contact sports.
- Respect the martial arts and develop professional ethics.
- Participate in and appreciate a well-rounded martial arts program.

The training class is held twice a week for consistent development. The training schedule is Monday and Thursdays 6:00 pm to & 7:00 pm for children 4 to 12 years old & ages 13 & up, class is 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm. The program was in started in January of 2011. The initial thrust has occurred and the program is up and running having served 46 participants to date. Of these 46, 30 are actively pursuing their belts. In the past 3 months, we have grown by an average of 5 participants a month and we will need to acquire additional mats to ensure adequate attention to each pupil.
