Please note that Tibon's Goju Ryu has not raised prices for the last 3 years to help our families during these hard Covid 19 economic times, which unfortunately we were shut down for business due to the Governor's mandate for 11-1/2 months. We are unfortunately having to raise our monthly tuition due to the rising costs of operating cost of a business, and new business laws starting January 1, 2022. The increase will amount to an additional \$5.00 per month more per students, which amounts to only 62 cents a class, less than a can of soda. I certainly hope this doesn't present a hardship to anyone, and please realize we always try very hard to give you more than your value in instruction and investment into your family member in traditional karate and Kobudo instruction.

With the new rates in effect, we can still offer quality instruction at \$25 - \$130 a month LESS than our competitors. The average costs of monthly tuitions nationwide are \$130.00-\$250 per month and are contractual we are non-contractual. In addition, most of my competitors only offer 45-minute classes, and do not possess the ability to teach at our level of technical quality. It is a common knowledge, and a proven business fact that we strive for excellence in developing our students in karate and life skill development. That is why we are a national rated developmental program, and place athletes on the United States National Karate Team on years they attend USA Team trials. Our specialty is Goju Ryu karate and the self defense aspect to the system.

We have placed students like **Sensei Joane Orbon** on the USA World Team and now the Philippine National Olympic Team ranking 7<sup>th</sup> in the world during her international competition travels. Sensei **Noah Helsby** on Team USA to Brazil in past years, and Senpai **Arin Helsby** and **Cayla Gapusan** to the USA National Team Pool as one of the top 3 athletes in the country in her respective black belt division. Only the best black belt athletes in the USA are selected to Team USA National Federation, member of the US Olympic Committee.

I hope you understand our reasoning for raising the tuition; these Covid 19 economic times have also challenged us to keeping our doors open with being closed for 11-1/2months. Due to the new State of California mandates for business minimum wages, we are trying to be more reasonable and affordable than our competitors without sacrificing our technical quality. If you are interested in prepaying your tuition, a discount is offered. We are offering an opportunity for those who wish to pay this year's annual cost before the new rates in 2022. This may be discussed with billing personnel.





## Tibon's, Stockton & Modesto GymStars, Hiers, United Bay Area Dojos

Please refer to dojo etiquette regarding conduct, dressing, and grooming and health standards. Please no jewelry or gum on the dojo floor. Cut nails and clean karate uniforms and showered clean students. Teens especially and adults wear deodorant for presentable training in the dojo.

Regarding in house sparring, we require Mandatory Safety equipment for Kumite:

All gear is to be furnished by the student except for headgear and chest protectors, which are at the discretion of the student or the parent for purchase. Some students like their own headgear and chest protector. <u>Students in color belt class are required the following:</u>

- 1. Hand gear and feet gear.
- 2. Mouthpiece
- 3. Groin protection for boys
- 4. Girls and boys can purchase the new body chest plates if desire.
- 5. Shin pads and forearm pads are optional but recommended for new students.
- 6. Headgear is optional but can purchase your own.
- 7. Chest gear is optional but can purchase your own.

Sparring equipment is mandatory for all students it must be in good condition with no cutting edges. Each student must keep nails trimmed and hair clean.

The students will have sparring in the color belt classes. The training is intense and strict no horseplay, or disrespectful attitudes will not be tolerated.

No contact to the face or groin is permitted. You may score to the face and groin, but you cannot make contact. No contact to the joints is allowed.

The system of rules and regulations enforced and controlled by a qualified instructor.

At Tibon's Goju Ryu we have very strong traditional ties to Karate in Japan, and Canada, and promote the development of strength of character, discipline, citizenship, good role modeling, and spirit.

Any infraction of the rules will terminate your enrollment.



Dear Parents, Students, Leadership, and Friends,

At **Tibon's Goju Ryu Fighting Arts**, the Main Karate Dojo at 923 N. Yosemite in Stockton this is what we are doing. **We MANDATORY HAND WASHING STATIONS at the front door** before anyone can even enter the facility. Then before sitting in the lobby and going on the karate mat for training EACH PERSON HAS OPTION TO WEAR MASK IF HAS BEEN **VACINATED. IF NOT VACCINATED WE REQUIRE YOU WEAR FACE MASK. THIS IS THE SAME FOR STUDENTS UNLESS BREATHING ISSUES OR VERY YOUNG. We would prefer distancing in the lobby and have provided outdoor seating with television monitor of students live training in the dojo.** Our goal is to have everyone in the dojo feeling safe and being safe from the virus.

- We have Mandatory Hand Washing Stations at front door before entering dojo.
- We ask parents and students wear a face mask is OPTIONAL IF HAS HAD VACCINATION with NO VACCINATION MUST STILL WEAR FACE MASK.
- We have wellness stations at the front desk including and sanitizer and tissues.
- We also have our sinks supplied with sanitizing soap in the restrooms.
- We have sanitizing station in each room.
- Staff are wiping down common surfaces between classes and throughout the day.
- Instructors and students are washing their hands before, in the middle, and after each class.
- All our mats are cleaned and sanitized with a hospital grade sanitizer each day.
- We have our employees cleaning daily to clean and sanitize the facility.
- Our classes have all been instructed to have CONTACT training with Karate basics, Kata(forms), strength and conditioning drills. Kumite(fighting) will resume since the Governor removed mandate on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- Our makeup class policy has been extended to give you credit to making up your classes when needed.
- We ask any families that are traveling to use a great deal of caution and ensure they are free from any illness before returning to class. Children are not really being affected by the virus and that is a blessing, but we do want to ensure we are keeping Grandma's and Grandpa's safe as we can.
